Muscles

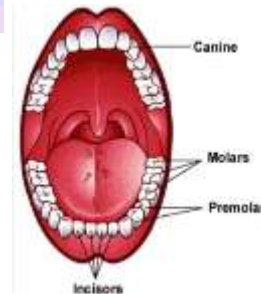
Soft tissues in the body that contract and relax to cause movement.
