Curriculum...

Make sure that the school always has an up to date contact number and address.

Keep my child at home if unwell.

Raise concerns with an appropriate person as early as possible.

Let the school know of issues that may affect my child's welfare or progress at school.

Curriculum...

Ensure that every child is taught at an appropriate and challenging level.

Provide a balanced and creative curriculum through a range of different approaches and experiences.

Provide a range of extra-curricular activities designed to enrich your children's learning experience.

Behaviour...

Share and agree expectations with children on a regular basis teaching respect for all things, themselves and each other.

Have high expectations of behaviour.

Make sure that all staff act as good role models.

Support your child to 'get things right' and recognise their achievement when they do.

Care for your child's safety and happiness.

Celebrate diverse backgrounds.

Homework, Attendance and Uniform...

Set appropriate homework regularly monitor, reward and applaud.

Maintain an accurate record of attendance monitor, reward and applaud.

Check school uniform regularly ... monitor, reward and applaud.

Welfare and Communication...

Make sure your child is kept safe and free from harm.

Welcome parents/carers into the life of the school and keep them informed about school matters, share dates about important events.

Follow procedures that we have in place to ensure the safety of your child on the school premises and school trips.

Administer medicines only with your written permission. The school will contact you if your child has a serious injury or is not well enough to stay in school.
