All activities are fully funded by the Economic and Social Research Council.

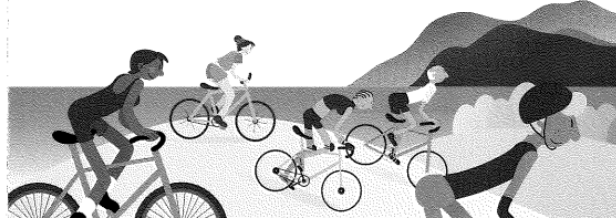
