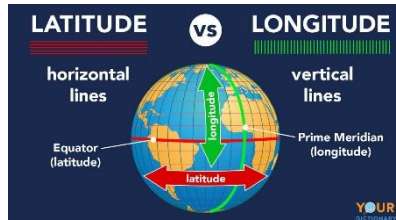

Co-ordinates  
A set of numbers and/or letters that show you a specific position on a map.

Hemisphere  
A half of the earth. Usually divided by the equator into the northern and southern hemisphere.

Observatory  
A place for observing and studying natural events on Earth or in space.

## The Tropics

Polar  
The area around the North or South Pole.

Precipitation  
Water particles that reach the ground including rain, hail or snow.



Equator  
An imaginary line around the Earth that goes exactly midway between the North Pole and South Pole and divides it into two equal halves.

Longitude  
Lines that run over the top of the Earth north to south.

Latitude  
Lines that run around the earth that run east to west.
