Modern Period 1900 - 1970

Drawing

A picture or diagram made with a pencil, pen or crayon.



Squares with Concentric Circles (1913)

Shapes within Kandinsky's work

Line

A long narrow mark.

Abstract

A representation of reality using shapes, colours and textures.

Expressionism

A style of work where the artist expresses themselves through emotion.

A feeling linked to mood.
