Florence Nightingale

A nurse who looked after soldiers in the Crimean War. She set up the Nightingale Training School for nurses in 1860.

Nurse

Somebody who takes cares of people who are sick or injured.

Medicine

A pill or liquid taken to prevent or cure an illness.

Crimean War

A war between Russia on one side and Britain , France, the Ottoman Empire and Sardinia on the other (1853-1856)

Hospital

A building where doctors and nurses take care of people who are ill or injured.

Patients

People who are being looked after by nurses and doctors.
